2.1 Report of the Officers

Officer comments included the following:

- A list of business agreements approved since the last Board meeting was shared.
- CEO Student Advisor Abril Garcia shared her reflections on the winter exhibition projects she attended, and her experience on the CEO Student Advisory.
- Chief Learning Officer Janie Griswold celebrated the accreditation review and 7 year renewal for the HTH Teacher Center, and 6 year WASC Accreditation renewal for HTHM and HTHNC. Janie also shared the positive results from the annual SDUSD and SBC Authorizer site visits.
- Chief Operations Officer Isaac Jones welcomed HTH's new Director of Human Resources Alicia Garcia. Isaac also shared the continuous improvement work that the various operations teams are working on, in partnership with the Center for Research on Equity and Innovation at the GSE. Isaac updated the Board on the present and active teacher hiring landscape.

Chairman and Board Member comments included the following:

 Board Chairman Gary Jacobs asked General Counsel Patrick Frost for an update on collective bargaining. Patrick provided that at the June Board meeting, HTH will sunshine to reopen the Wages article to the Certificated unit, and sunshine HTH's initial proposals to the Classified unit, after which collective bargaining with each respective unit can begin.

- Gary Jacobs asked the Officers for an update on CBA implementation and the Joint Evaluation Committee. Patrick shared that HTH and HTEC leadership have been meeting monthly, with the purpose being to collaboratively understand each other's priorities and dialogue about them. All retroactive pay has been distributed, wages have been adjusted, and the new sick leave calculation has been implemented. Diana Cornejo-Sanchez discussed the Joint Evaluation Committee's objective to develop a process that helps educators grow. The committee has partnered with the SDCOE's Educator Effectiveness & Evaluation Program to collaborate in this work. Board Trustee Lida Rafia celebrated the collaborative approach in establishing this evaluation process.
- Gary Jacobs shared that the CEO Search Committee has been established, consisting of 2 Board members, 2 Directors, 2 Teachers, and 1 Dean. The committee will soon convene to begin vetting the CEO applicants, and will share further progress at the June Board meeting.
